Then, every October we recalculate your budget payment amount based on your actual usage from the previous 12-months, taking into account any outstanding balance or credit. We then send you a letter with your new monthly budget payment for the coming year. Buffalo Chicken Enchiladas

Ingredients:

3 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted and more for greasing pan	1 bunch of scallions, thinly sliced, white and green parts separated
4 cups of shredded rotisserie chicken	1/4 teaspoon of ground cumin
8 ounces cream cheese, at room temperature	16 corn tortillas
2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese	2 tablespoons of crumbled blue cheese
1 cup of hot sauce, plus more for serving, such as Frank's	2 tablespoons blue cheese dressing

Directions

- Preheat the oven to 400 degrees F. Butter a 9-by-13-inch baking dish.
- Mix the chicken, cream cheese, 1 cup of the Cheddar, 1/3 cup of the hot sauce, white parts of the scallions
 and cumin in a large bowl until well combined. Stir together the butter, remaining 2/3 cup hot sauce and 3
 tablespoons water in a medium bowl.
- Microwave the tortillas in batches until warm, softened and foldable, about 30 seconds. Keep warm between damp paper towels.
- Spoon a portion of the chicken mixture down the middle of each tortilla and roll up. Place them side by side, seam-side down, in the prepared pan. Pour the hot sauce mixture over the tortillas. Sprinkle with the remaining 1 cup Cheddar and the blue cheese and bake until the cheese is melted and bubbly. 15 to 17 minutes.
- Drizzle the blue cheese dressing over the enchiladas and sprinkle with the scallion greens. Serve with more hot sauce. For more delicious 30-minute recipes, visit www.foodnetwork.com
