

RECIPE

Red, White and Blue Fruit Tart

Ingredients

For the crust:

1 pie crust from a box

For the filling:


- 1-8 ounce package cream cheese, softened
- /a ann angar
- ½ cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla bean paste

For the fruit topping:

- 4 large strawberries, sliced
- 11/2 cups blackberries
- 1/4 cup blueberries
- 1/2 cup raspberries

Instructions

- Heat the oven to 450°F.
- Carefully unroll the dough and place in the tart pan. Use your fingers to press the dough firmly into the pan, making sure to press along the sides as well before pricking with a fork (to prevent air bubbles).
- Bake the tart crust for 10-12 minutes or until golden brown.
 Allow the crust to cool completely before adding the cream cheese filling.
- Add the cream cheese, sugar, and vanilla bean paste to a medium bowl and use a mixer to beat at medium speed until smooth. Evenly spread the filling to cover the entire crust.
- 5. Arrange fruit as shown (or in any pattern you like) on top of the cream cheese filling.



Natural gas is a commodity and its price is determined by the market, based on several factors. A regulated utility is not allowed to make or lose money on the cost of gas as mandated by New Mexico's Public Regulation Commission, so the cost of purchasing and transporting gas to Zia's system is passed directly through to the customer as the Gas Cost Factor. Effective April 1, 2025, the Gas Cost Factor for customers in Dona Ana County is \$0.4822 per ccf, an increase from \$0.2534. The Gas Cost Factor for all other Zia customers remains unchanged from October 1, 2024 rates; Lea/Eddy County at \$0.3685 per ccf, Lincoln County at \$0.3232 per ccf, and Colfax County at \$0.3785 per ccf.
